

N. St. Mary's Public Safety Meeting Follow-Up Comprehensive Plan

In response to concerns expressed by residents living in the neighborhoods adjacent to the N. St. Mary's Strip associated with parking violations, speeding motorists, excessive noise and the behavior of intoxicated patrons from area bars and clubs, the SAPD, Center City Development Office and Transportation & Capital Improvements have developed a comprehensive plan to address the stated concerns.

Coordination with Area Businesses

On Thursday, February 14, SAPD, CCDO and the Office of Councilman Trevino will meet with representatives from several businesses along the N. St. Mary's Strip to discuss the following:

- Specific concerns identified by the neighborhood
- Comprehensive Plan overview
- Actions that can be taken by businesses to address concerns

SAPD Strategy

During the February 7 Community meeting, the following issues were noted for action. It is important to note that while officers will focus on addressing the issues below, SAPD will work to proactively address any violations or concerns observed in the area. In addition all businesses will be observed to ensure compliance with all applicable laws.

Establishments

- Hi-tones: noise complaints/over serving alcohol
- Paper Tiger: noise complaints
- Limelight: noise complaints/over serving alcohol
- Squeeze Box: noise complaints/over serving alcohol

Speeding/Parking

- 100 block of Valdez: speeding/Parking in No Parking zones
- 300/400 block of E. Craig Place: Parking issues
- E. Courtland Place & Kendall St: Parking issues
- McCullough & E. Ashby Place: Speeding

The following units will participate in the project which is scheduled for February 13 through March 9 with a specific focus on Wednesday through Sunday (10:00pm – 3:00am). At the conclusion of the project a final report detailing results will be provided to the community:

- **Central SAFFE Unit**
 - Patrol area
 - Coordinate follow-up meetings with residents
 - Address Illegal Parking
- **DWI/Traffic Unit**
 - DWI enforcement along corridor
 - Coordinate with TCI/CCDO to address parking violations
- **VICE Unit**
 - Investigate alleged alcohol violations
